#### OLD BUSINESS

##### Trail Stations Proposal

Mark Shipley, of Mark Creative Services, brought in the mock display for the new trail station signs. The existing posts will be used, with all-new display caps on top. These will be framed with the same cedar of the existing posts and treated. The new display maps will inlay from the frame just enough to prevent moisture damage, while still remaining secure. New graphics have been made and will be printed directly flush onto the signboard. Text on the signs will be revised to better fit each station's specific location. A motion was made and approved unanimously to take this proposal to the Board.

Development of a larger sign with the entire history is also in progress.

##### Update Boat Park

It was decided that we will not wait for the fee approval to fill the empty boat park slots. As there is a waiting list, we will allow these people to use the boat park slots for the time being and postpone the fee decision for a later date. It was noted that upon charging a fee in the future, both the sign-up slip and the rules sheet need to be updated as well.

##### Review Trail Management Plan

There are a couple of trails that need to be reassigned. As Bob Jameyson is no longer on the committee and wishes to relinquish duties, his care of the trail around Willow lake will need to be taken care of by someone else, as well as Scot Stromsta's care of Old Field Trail. Contacts will be made with those who have shown interest in volunteering their time, as well as putting an ad in the July Warbler newsletter recruiting Trail Management Committee members.

##### Security, Recycling Area

Overall, the boosted security has had a positively noticeable impact. A suggestion was made to see about getting another surveillance camera in a different area. Footage can be saved and gone back over for study after an incident.
