Subject: Minutes from Meeting of September 21, 2011

Following are the items we discussed and Action that needs to be taken:

- Trail Trimming -- Ron Williams reported on trimming the trails. His crew spent one week trimming the trail width and cleaning up overhanging branches. Looks good. Work yet needs to be done on the small angel trail behind The Shores.
 - ACTION – Ron will clean up the angle trail behind The Shores within a few weeks.
- Beach Cleanup – Ron has had a crew wade into Lake Hill N Brook and rake out lily pads. He removed a pickup truck load of lily pads. Next we plan to use the Goat brush hog to mow the area in front and to the sides of the water. This will expose more lily pads and we can look at further removal in 2012.
 - ACTION -- No further action this year.
- Status of the Goat Brush Hog -- The Goat demo is scheduled for the week of Oct. 8th. I will notify the committee of the exact time and date before the actual demo. If you wish to attend, feel free to do such.
 - ACTION – Jim Gunderson will notify the Trail Committee of the date and time of the demo.
- Trail Signs – The signs are being installed. Art Falk has agreed to write an article for the Warbler about the new signs. Thank you Art.
 - ACTION – Art Falk will get with Robin and arrange a Warbler article regarding the new signage.
- Boat Park – Ron Tanis reported as details on a mystery boat that has been solved and the boat is now registered. A cable has been cut on a PVH canoe and the canoe was used and put back in the assigned slot without being locked up. Also, a fishing boat was stolen this summer, Dr. Ira, and we have not been able to locate. It was suggested we purchase a sports camera and mount in a concealed area to watch this area. There are cameras available for about \$150 that will take pictures of the area triggered on a motion detector. This camera can be mounted in a nearby tree and help ID any illegal activity. The committee requested that I approach the Board for approval for this purchase. Ron and Jim will work out the mounting and monitoring system
 - ACTION – Jim Gunderson will request funds from the Board for this purchase.

The meeting ended at 8:45 AM. The next meeting will be in the spring of 2012, time and date to be announced.
