ENVIRONMENTAL & ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE

The EARC primarily reviews and approves all exterior building alterations and property improvements within Parkview Hills. It is also responsible for reviewing requests for tree and vegetation removal, erosion control, waterways maintenance and land use. Working with the PHCA Board, the EARC also oversees projects, provides background information, and makes recommendations on short and long-range projects within the community. The EARC meets monthly at 3:00 p.m. on the fourth Wednesday in the clubhouse library.
